Saturday 30 August

Some roads in the Sydney CBD are closed between 2am – 10am.

- TCS Sydney Mini Marathon presented by ASICS starts 07:30
- Event finishes 11:00

Sunday 31 August

Major roads & cycleways will be closed between 2am and 4pm in North Sydney, the Sydney CBD, The Rocks, Millers Point, Barangaroo, Pyrmont, Darlinghurst, Moore Park, Centennial Park, Kensington, and Kingsford.

- TCS Sydney Marathon presented by ASICS (elite wheelchair) starts 06:15
- TCS Sydney Marathon presented by ASICS starts 06:30
- TCS Sydney Marathon presented by ASICS 10km starts 08:45
- Events finishes 16:00

For the safety of runners and spectators, there will be significant road closures associated with the TCS Sydney Marathon between 2am and 4pm.

See below detailed information on local access arrangements in each area, including maps. All efforts have been made to maintain vehicle access for residents where possible.

We strongly advise that you take the following steps to help minimise the impact of these significant road closures:

- Avoid non-essential travel where possible leave your car at home and DON'T DRIVE in areas along or surrounding the course. Significant delays are expected with major detours in place.
- Plan your trip be aware of road closure times & locations, and if you must drive on event day plan your route in advance and allow for extra trave time.
- For those needing to drive, the Cross City Tunnel will be free from 5am to 4.30pm only on event day, Sunday 31 August.
- **Use public transport** trains and metro services will continue to run to and from the city, with additional early morning services. Keep in mind that due to road closures buses and light rail services will be affected, so plan your trip ahead of time.
- <u>Taxi/rideshare drop off locations</u>

Resident Parking / Special Event Clearways:

- Check signage If you need to access your vehicle during the event, park in a legal space outside of the closure footprint. Special event clearway parking restrictions are strict no parking zones and will be in effect across the course, avoid being towed and move your vehicle on Saturday night as many clearways come into effect midnight leading into Sunday. Some clearways will also be in effect the day before on Saturday.
- The event will reimburse displaced parking if conditions of the parking <u>reimbursement</u> form are met.

3S SYDNEY MARATHON PUBLIC COMMUNICATION

Major roads will be closed restricting access east/west across the course from the Opera House, through the city, Darlinghurst down to Moore Park.

Key roads will be closed between 4am and 3pm/3.30pm including:

- Park St / William St between Elizabeth St and Crown St from 5am to 3pm

- Oxford St from Liverpool St to Flinders St Flinders St from Oxford St to Moore Park Rd College St between Macquarie St and Oxford St
- Macquarie St from the Opera House to Hyde Park
- 5am to 1pm: Anzac Pde closed northbound from Dacey Ave to Fitzroy St, Fitzroy St closed at South Dowling St, Cleveland St closed westbound from Anzac Pde to South Dowling St, Alison Rd closed between Darley Rd and Anzac Pde, Dacey Ave closed between South Dowling St and Anzac Pde and the full closure of Anzac Pde between Gardeners Rd, Kingsford and Avoca St, Kingsford.
- Motorists will be detoured around Anzac Pde via Bunnerong Rd, Maroubra Rd and Avoca St in both directions.
- 5am to 1.30pm: full closure of Anzac Pde between Dacey Ave, Moore Park and Gardeners Rd, Kingsford, Cleveland St closed eastbound from South Dowling St to Anzac Pde, Anzac Pde closed southbound from Lang Rd to Dacey Ave.
- Heavy traffic is expected in the Eastern Distributor in both directions due to the closures of Dacey Ave, Anzac Pde and Cleveland St between 5am and 1.30pm
- Moore Park 5am to 3pm: Anzac Pde closed southbound from Moore Park Rd to Lang Rd, Moore Park Rd closed westbound from Oxford St to Anzac Pde, Driver Ave closed and Lang Rd closed between Anzac Pde and Cook Rd. Robertson Rd and surrounding local streets also closed. Centennial Parklands closed.
- No access from east of Anzac Pde to west of Anzac Pde until 1pm when Dacey Ave/Alison Rd reopens, or use Cross City Tunnel (toll-free until 4.30pm).

For drivers needing to travel east/west across the course on event day during these hours, the only available route is via Gardeners Rd and Bunnerong Rd or the Cross City Tunnel. The tunnel will be toll-free from 5am to 4.30pm. Long delays are expected so motorists are urged to avoid unnecessary travel, and if you do need to drive allow for plenty of extra travel time on the roads.
